Registration deadline: **11/07/2024** for the examinations on 01/08/2024 and **16/07/2024** for the examinations on 06/08/2024.

In case of registration with an admission certificate (“Zulassungsbescheinigung”), this document must be submitted no later than 11/07/2024 for the examinations on 01/08/2024 and not later than 16/07/2024 for the examinations on 06/08/2024 at the secretariat of the chair. **This also applies to admissions certificates of exchange students. After these dates, no more registration will be accepted!**

Deregistration: A deregistration is mandatory (see examination regulations § 9). If the examination is not attended without valid reason, it is considered failed!

Tools and aids: Only non-programmable calculators and a dictionary may be used.
